Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining, And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the aforesaid premises unto the said William Blasingame and Roger Loveland their heirs and assigns forever against myself my heirs executors administrators and assigns and against no other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
