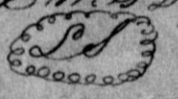

sents that I Martin Shelton of the District and State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of One hundred and eighty nine Dollars and fourteen cents to me in hand paid by Eleanor Shelton of the District and State aforesaid the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained sold conveyed and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell convey and confirm unto the said Eleanor Shelton her heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and sixty five and a half acres of land be the same more or less situated in Greenville District aforesaid on the head branches of Canoree River also on the branches of the north fork of Saluda River viz beginning on a small red oak corner made between William Pates and myself near the head of a branch the waters of Canoree River thence N 50. 71. 7 chains and 91 links to a Red oak stump corner at the road Burns line thence along said road a north east
