


Squire Calhoun  
To  
James Holiday. } Deed for 119  $\frac{9}{100}$  Acres.

South Carolina I know all men by these presents Greenville District. That I, Squire Calhoun, of the State and District aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and sixty-four  $\frac{6}{100}$  Dollars to me in hand paid by James Holiday of the same place, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said James Holiday a small tract of land lying in the State and District aforesaid, on the north side of Saluda River containing one hundred and nineteen  $\frac{9}{100}$  acres (more or less) it being a part of a tract originally granted to John Martin dated 3<sup>d</sup> September Anno Domini 1787 beginning on a stone 3<sup>x</sup> on the River and running thence N 77 E. 54.50. to a stake 3<sup>x</sup> bounded by Tully Bolling's land thence South 35 O. 22.50 to a stake or stone 3<sup>x</sup> bounded by John Cooley's land thence S. 77 W. 53.50 to an Ash 3<sup>x</sup> in said River bounded by S. Calhoun thence up the meanders of the river to the beginning. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the same belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said James Holiday his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said James Holiday his heirs and assigns against myself, and my heirs, and against every other person or persons whomever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this the thirtieth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty-three.
