


To all to whom these presents shall come.  
I, William Mc Goodlett, Sheriff of  
Greenville District and State aforesaid, send

Greeting: Whereas, by virtue of a Writ of Fieri Facias, issued  
out of the Court of Common Pleas, held for the District of Green-  
ville the twenty seventh day of October in the year of our Lord  
one thousand eight hundred and forty-one at the suit of James  
Jones to me directed, commanding me, that of the goods and chattels,  
lands and tenements, of Lewis Croft to levy the sum of One Hundred  
and nineteen & <sup>85</sup>/<sub>100</sub> Dollars damages and costs, I have seized and taken  
of the lands and tenements of the said Lewis Croft, being his interest  
or distributive share in all that certain piece, parcel and tract of land,  
containing more or less Three Hundred Acres, situate and being in the District  
of Greenville on the waters of Reedy Fork, adjoining John H. Joyce, Garrett  
Seager et al, being the same whereon his mother Mrs. Croft now lives.

And whereas, the said premises, with their appurtenances, since the  
seizure by me made, by virtue of the said Writ of fieri facias before  
mentioned, have been exposed to sale at public vendue, and purchased  
by James Jones of the District and State aforesaid, for the sum of  
Fifty-Two Dollars, being the highest sum that was bidden therefor.

Now know ye, That I, William Mc Goodlett, Sheriff aforesaid,  
by virtue of the said Writ of fieri facias aforesaid, to me directed and de-  
livered as aforesaid, and by virtue of the statute in such case made and  
provided, and for and in consideration of the said sum of Fifty-Two  
Dollars to me in hand paid, or secured to be paid by the said James  
Jones, the receipt and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge, have grant-  
ed, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto  
the said James Jones his heirs and assigns forever, the said tract, piece and  
parcel of land, with its appurtenances, and all the estate, right, title and  
interest, which the said Lewis Croft, of right had, of, in, and to the same.
