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Deed to Land.

South Carolina, I now all men by these Greenville District presents, That I, William P. Gantt, of Greenville District in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of Twelve Hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by John H. Marsteller of Greenville District in the State aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said John H. Marsteller, All that Tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in Greenville District containing Two hundred and thirty-two Acres be the same more or less, Bounding and bounding as follows, to wit, Beginning at a stake, below a large Rock, formerly a Wt. oak 3x, running thence N. 44° 50' to stake in a Ditch, thence to a Willow 3x, thence along the Ditch line to a S. Gum 3x. thence N. 80° W. 30.50 to a small P. O. 3x. thence S. 17° E. 13.25, thence on Wilson Ferry road line S. 13° E. 42.50 to a stake, thence E. 19 to a Pine, thence N. 14.50 to a Stake 3x, thence along the branch line to the beginning - bounded by the lands of Judge Gantt, J. Cleveland, Mr. Benson and others - the same being composed of two adjacent tracts of Land, the one conveyed by Douglass Secretary to Judge Gant by Deed bearing date the 11<sup>th</sup> day of July, 1827, reference being thereto had, the other tract or parcel of Land, conveyed by Thomas Crawford to Richard Gantt by Deed bearing date the 7<sup>th</sup> day of July 1824, both of which Tracts were conveyed by one Deed, bearing date the 25<sup>th</sup> day of December, 1833, by Richard Gantt to me, the whole being governed by the above described Miles and bonds, as surveyed by John Watson, Esq: the 30<sup>th</sup> day of April 1844 - However reference being thereto had, to the different Deeds above alluded to together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining: To have and to hold, all and singular the Premises before mentioned, unto the said John H. Marsteller his Heirs and Assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular the said Premises, unto the said John H. Marsteller his Heirs and Assigns, against me and my Heirs, and against every Person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same, in any part thereof.
