Deed of Gift.

The State of South Carolina.

Know all men by these presents, that I, Tully Bolling of Greenville District and State aforesaid, as well for, and in consideration of the natural love and affection I have for my son Thaddeus C. Bolling of the District and State aforesaid, as in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars to me in hand paid by the said Thaddeus C. Bolling, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, ~~Have~~ give, bargain, sell, conveyed and delivered and by these presents ~~do~~ give, bargain, sell, convey and deliver unto the said Thaddeus C. Bolling the following Slaves namely Sicily, Louisa, Annanias, Hesteriah, Anthony, Terry, Manns, Rachel, Ridley, Clarissa, David, Elija, George, and Moses with the future increase of the females To Have and to Hold all and singular the aforesaid further Slaves and the future increase of all and singular the females above named unto the said Thaddeus C. Bolling and his Heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself, my Heirs, Executors, Administrators and assigns, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the slaves aforesaid and the future increase of the females unto the said Thaddeus C. Bolling and his Heirs, against myself and my Heirs, and against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the said Slaves or any one of them or any part thereof.

In witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this the twenty-eighth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty-nine and in sixty-fourth year of the sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.
