G. Vance, thence S. 1. E. 30. 50 to Ironwood 3x bounded by Allen Chandler, thence S. 80 W. to a stone 3x thence N. 60 W. 3. 50. to a Red oak 3x thence S. 67 W. 2. to a stone 3x thence S. 80 W. 20 to a Post oak 3x thence S. 57 W. 10. 65. to a stake 3x thence S. 44 E. 25. to a stone 3x thence W. 10, to a Red oak 3x bounded by William G.
