Know all men by these presents that I Aaron Creamer of the State and District aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One hundred and five dollars to me in hand paid by Jacob Reese of the same place, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain sell & release unto the said Jacob Reese a certain tract of Land, containing fifty two and a half acres, more or less, situate, and lying in the State and District aforesaid, on one of the branches of the big Rudy Fork, waters of Rudy River, beginning on a Dead oak 34 m. thence N. 69 W. 22.50 to a Rock 34 m. thence along the new road S. 50 chains to a Rock corner n. m. thence N. 35 E. 19 chs to a Hickory 34 m. thence S 69 E 28.50 across new road to a Rock 34 m. thence S 45 W. 22.50 to the beginning Corner adjoining lands of Maj. M. Perry - on this last line - on North, Jacob Reese, on the West Mrs. Nancy Hiatt, and on the East said Aaron Creamer -
