 I, George Bain, Sen^r of District and State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and thirty Dollars to me paid by James Bain of District and State aforesaid: Have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said James Bain a certain tract of land containing seventy-seven acres (more or less) situate in Greenville District on the East side of Quety River Beginning on a Red Oak 8x on bank of said River at the ragged Shoal Thence on lands of William C. Dacus N. 50 E. 47.80 to a Dogwood 3x Thence on lands of William Bain N. 71 1/2 W. 35.50 to a Maple on bank of River 3x 3x Thence down said River bounded on the middle of said River to the beginning corner Together with all and singular the rights, members, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises here mentioned unto the said James Bain his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said James Bain his heirs and assigns, Against myself, and my heirs and against any other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
