 J. Waddill of said State and district have granted bargain sold
 and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release
 unto the said Samuel J. Waddill his heirs and assigns forever all that
 tract or parcel of land containing forty-eight and one half acres more
 or less thirty-one and one half acres being a part of a tract of land ori-
 ginally granted to Jesse Duncan and also more acres being a part of a
 tract of land granted to Parkside D. Garrison and Charles Garrison in the
 North joining land of Parkside D. Garrison and in the South joining land of
 P. J. Waddill situated in said District and on Caluda River and hath such
 bounds and marks as follows, viz Beginning at a pine stump S 53 N. 34
 42 thence to a Black Gum on said river S x thence along the river 10 chs
 to an oak to a maple S x thence N. 86 E. 24. 50 to a pine stump S x
