The State of South Carolina,
Know all men by these presents,
that I, Mary Odum, of Greenville
Dist and State aforesaid for and

in consideration of the natural love and affection which I bear
unto my son William Odum and for his better preferment and
the increase of his station and also in consideration of the sum
of one dollar to me in hand paid by my said son William
at and before the sealing and delivery hereof the receipt whereof
I do hereby acknowledge have given, granted, bargained and sold,
and by these presents do give, grant, bargain and sell unto my said
son William Odum the items following to wit one cow and five pigs
three year old shoats one small table three chairs and one chest
to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned
herby given and granted unto the said William Odum my son his
executors and administrators for ever, in his own proper right and title.

It is moreover declared by these presents that for and in consideration
of the above preamble and perfunctory recitation to my son William that
in like manner and for the same considerations I have given granted,
bargained and sold and by these presents do give, grant bargain and
sell and confirm unto my daughter Sally Odum one cow, one feather
bed, stead, and furniture, three chairs, one spinning wheel, one year old
shoat three head of geese one set of dippers one small oven one wash
pot herby confirmed as to my son William.

It is also moreover declared by these presents, that for and in con-
sideration as to my son William Odum above mentioned, and confirmed in like
manner I herby have given, granted bargained and sold unto my son-in-law
Henry Wright and wife Nancy one sorrel mare and heifer granting
one year old shoat one feather bed, stead, and furniture, two head geese
one spinning wheel and one pair of cotton cards herby confirming as to
my son William recitation.
