Know all men by these presents that the Benjamin McKemie and Zely McKemie, being entitled to one distributive share of the Real Estate of David McCoy in right of Zely McKemie, who is a daughter of the said David McCoy for and in consideration of Three Hundred Dollars to us in hand paid by Robert Cox the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents sell and convey & forever release & quit claim to the said Robert Cox all our interest right title claim or demand to any and all of the Real Estate of which the said David McCoy was possessed and of which we were entitled to an distributive share as Heirs at Law of the said David McCoy, and also to our share of any fund or funds which may be in the hands of the Commissioner in Equity for Greenville District or in the hands of any other person or persons whatsoever, either in money, bonds or notes arising from the sale of any or all of the Real Estate of the said David McCoy - To Have & hold the said matters and things herein and hereby conveyed to the said Robert Cox his heirs and assigns forever.
