And I do hereby bind myself my my heirs Executors & Administrators to warrant & forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Larkin Cannon his heirs & assigns against myself my heirs & against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
