 I Thomas M. Cox of the district and
 state aforesaid, for and in consideration
 of the sum of one hundred and thirty dollars to me paid by William
 H. Watson of the same state and district have granted, bargained, sold
 and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and re-
 lease unto the said William H. Watson, a certain lot or piece of land
 situate in the town of Greenville in the district and state aforesaid, and
 hath such bounds, marks &c as follows viz. Beginning at a stake 3x
 on the line of said Watson's lot, thence along said line N. 73 W. 176 1/2
 feet to a stake 3x on Jackson Street, thence down said street S. 17 W.
 4 1/2 feet to a stake on said street near Ruddy River, thence S. 32 1/2 E.
 231 1/2 feet to a hole, made in a rock near the said River, thence N.
 17 E. 155 feet to the beginning corner, it being a part of a lot of land
 sold and conveyed by Vandyke M. Stue to said Cox the 7th day of October
 A. D. 1837, and recorded in the Registers office of said District the 20th
 November A. D. 1837, in book C. Pages 333 and 336. Together with all
 and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to
 the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining.
 To have and to hold, all and singular the premises before mention-
 ed unto the said William H. Watson, his heirs and assigns forever. And
