South Carolina I know all men by Greenville District. ⁱⁿ these presents, that I, John Mc Peden of the State and District aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred dollars to me in hand paid, by Robert Mc Peden, of the same State and District, have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents, do grant bargain sell and release, unto the said Robert Mc Peden, all that Tract or parcel of Land, Lying on the South side of Raburns Creek, in waters of the same, begining on Stake in old field made for Thos. J. Peden and John Mc Peden 3x. or Thence in Thos. J. Pedens land S. 19 $\frac{3}{4}$ E. 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ 00 to Smale Persimmon 3x on the said Thos. J. Pedens land, Thence 75 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 14.00 to Hickory 3x3x0. and Post oak 3.0. in Baby Tress Land Thence N. 14 $\frac{3}{4}$ W. to Post oak 3.0 and Pine 3x0 on Silas Mc Moneys Land, and John T. Pedens 55.50 to Post oak 3x0. Thence N. 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 4.25. to Pine near the Branch. Thence S. 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. or Alexander H. Pedens Land, to the South side of the Waggon Road to Stake, Thence 33 Rods to Black oak, on South side of the above named Road, Thence 45 Rods, Through the middle of the Spring and branch, to a maple, on the East bank of the branch on or near Thomas J. Pedens Land, Thence on said Thomas J. Pedens land to the begining, containing ninety eight and a half acres, be the same more or less. Together with all and singular the premises above described, the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the same, belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining, to have and to hold all and singular the premises above mentioned, unto the said Robert Mc Peden, his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors or Administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises, unto the said Robert Mc Peden, his heirs and assigns, against myself my heirs and every other Person lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof, in witness whereof I have set my hand and seal this Twenty eighth day of October - in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty five, and in the Twenty fifth year of the Independence of the United States of America.
