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State of South Carolina ~~was~~ Know all  
Greenville District. I now by  
these presents that I John Bald-  
win of the State and District as-

fured for and in consideration of the natural love and affection  
which I have and bear towards my son Thomas Baldwin of the  
same State and District and also in consideration of the sum of  
Five Dollars to me paid by the said Thomas Baldwin have gran-  
ted, bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant  
bargain sell and release unto the said Thomas Baldwin a cer-  
tain piece parcel and tract of land situate lying and being in  
said District on Rocky Creek waters of Reedy River being apart  
of the tract of land on which I now lie, and composed of all  
that part of the lands lying South of the roads leading from Spur-  
tburg Court House to Wilsons Bridge (Known as the Georgia Road)  
which was conveyed to me by John Reed by deed bearing date 4<sup>th</sup>  
October A.D. 1796, and by W<sup>m</sup> Nicholson by deed bearing date 28<sup>th</sup>  
February A.D. 1810. except a part of twenty acres conveyed by me  
to Peter Simpson at the East end of the Tract. Said land now conveyed  
being bounded by lands of Peter Simpson on the East, Widow Louisa  
Elbert on the South, Thomas Goldsmith on the South, John Cox on  
the West, and the aforesaid Georgia Road on the North, (which  
road separates the land now conveyed from a tract this day conveyed to  
my son Richard Baldwin) containing One hundred and ninety acres  
more or less and being all the land which I hold on the South  
side of the said Georgia Roads except part of a tract of thirteen acres  
purchased by me of John Moore. Together with all and singular  
the rights members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said  
premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

Reserving to myself all and entire the right, title interest  
and estate of in and to the said tract of land now conveyed, during
