William West, Executor of the last Will and Testament of Isaac West, deceased, for and in consideration, of the sum of One hundred and Sixty five Dollars to me in hand paid, by James West, of the district and State aforesaid, I have bargained, sold and released and by these presents, do bargain sell and deliver unto the said James West, a certain Tract or parcel of land situate and lying in Greenville District, and State aforesaid, in the waters of Saluda River, containing two hundred and fifty acres be the same more or less, beginning in a W. C. corner, the said Mosely and James West - thence nearly N. E. course to a conditional S. E. corner the said Mosely and James West - thence Eastwardly to the Creek to a stake corner on the East bank of the said Creek, thence a conditional line between the said Mosely and James Crofford to a W. C. oak corner on the East side of Rubins Martin's line - thence S. W. to a stake corner on Thomas Hooper's line - thence N. a conditional line made by Richard Hooper and Thomas Hooper to a S. E. corner - thence N. E. to a Spanish Oak, x on the Road - thence a conditional line between the said Mosely and West to a S.
