R. Pinsett's, West by Land formerly Glasingames now Mrs. Toms' Lot by D. Hoke's Lands and Eastward by Estate of Governor J. Allston being the Land which was conveyed on the 10 January 1843 by Wm. C. Anderson to the said James S. Guignard excepting two & three quarter acres exchanged by said James S. Guignard with David Hoke also one acre and three quarters of Land adjoining the above Tract which was conveyed on the 10 February 1845 by David Hoke to the said James S. Guignard, which said original Titles from William C. Anderson and David Hoke and also Mrs. Anderson's renunciation of same are now given up with these Presents to the said Whitford Smith also delivered with these Presents J. M. Glasingame's Original Titles to Elijah H. Simkins and Francis W. Pickens Titles (original) as Executor of Elijah H. Simkins to the said William C. Anderson.
