This Indenture made this the twenty ninth of January in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven between John West of South

Carolina and District of Greenville of the one part and Amos Vaughn of the same state and place of the other part witnesseth that the sd John West for and in consideration of the sum of twenty five Dollars to him in hand paid by the sd Amos Vaughn the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledge by the said hath bargained and by these presents doth bargain and sell to the sd Amos Vaughn a certain piece of land containing by Estimation five acres lying and being in Greenville District in branches of Prussy Creek it being a part of a tract of land originally granted to Paul Abner grant bearing date the first of January 1785 and also a part of a tract of land originally granted to Aaron Kemp grant bearing date the fifth of January 1795 and deduced from Aaron Kemp to the sd Reubin Redman and deduced from Reubin Redman to the sd John West beginning on a stake on Quinnes line in a branch from the E. corner of Branch to a stake corner on Quinnes line thence along sd line to
