

 with its appurtenances, unto the said Tho: P. Butler his heirs  
 and assigns forever, as fully and absolutely as I the said David  
 Hoke Sheriff might, could, or ought to grant, bargain and sell the  
 same, by virtue of the statute aforesaid, and the said Writ of fieri  
 facias or otherwise.
