Whereas, by virtue of a Writ of Fieri Facias, issued out of the Court of Common Pleas, held for the District of Greenville, tested the Twenty Fourth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Forty Three at the suit of S. H. Erby, to me directed, commanding me, that of the goods and chattels, lands and tenements, of Waddy Thompson Senior, to pay the sum of Nine hundred Dollars, damages and costs, I have seized and taken of the lands and tenements of the said Waddy Thompson all that certain piece, parcel and tract of land, containing Ten acres, situate and being in the District of Greenville, on the Augusta road Three fourth of a mile from Greenville Court House, adjoining lands of Waddy M. Bee, and William M. Goodlett.

And whereas, the said premises, with their appurtenances, since the seizure by me made, by virtue of the said Writ of Fieri Facias before mentioned, have been exposed to sale at public vendue, and purchased by Waddy Thompson Junior of the District of Greenville for the sum of Six hundred Dollars being the highest sum that was bidder therefor: Now know ye, that I David Hoke Sheriff aforesaid, by virtue of the said Writ of fieri facias aforesaid, to me directed and delivered as aforesaid, and by virtue of the statute in such case made and provided, and for and in consideration of the said sum of Six Hundred Dollars to me in hand paid, or secured to be paid by the said Waddy Thompson Junr. the receipt and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said Waddy Thompson Junior, his and assigns forever, the said tract, piece and parcel of land, with its appurtenances, and all the estate, rights, title and interests, which the said Waddy Thomp-
