Garrison all our right title interest and estate of in or to all and singular the real and personal estate of John Jones deceased late of said State and District, and we do hereby authorize and empower the said Charles C. Garrison to receive from any person in whose hands the same may be, all amounts due to us by virtue of our interest in estate in any of the real and personal estate of the said John Jones decd. and ratify his receipts for the same against us and our heirs forever.
