Present, That I Joseph Headden Sr. of Greenville District in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the natural love and affection which I have and bear towards Joseph Headden Jr. the natural son of my daughter Ann Headden deceased, and also in consideration of the sum of One hundred Dollars to me paid by the said Joseph Headden Jr. and also in consideration of an obligation made by the said Joseph Headden Jr. to pay to me the sum of Twenty Dollars per annum during my natural life have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Joseph Headden Jr. all that Lot of Land on the Town of Greenville S. C. in which I now live, situate on the South side of Buncombe Road and Bounded by Buncombe Road, Laurens Street, Coffee Street, and Richardson Street. Reserving to myself for my sole use and occupation during my natural life the use occupation and possession of the west room on the first story of the dwelling house, with all such privileges rights and easements as are necessary for the comfortable and convenient occupation of the same as a place of abode by me during my natural life.

Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Creditments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining: To Have and to Hold, all and singular the Premises beforementioned, unto the said Joseph Headden Jr. his Heirs and Assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular the said Premises, unto the said Joseph Headden Jr. his Heirs and Assigns, against me and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
