McCawell his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said George W. McCawell his heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against every person whosoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
