

And whereas, the said premises, with their appurtenances, since the seizure by me made, by virtue of the said Writ of fieri facias before mentioned, have been exposed to sale at public vendue, and purchased by Stephen Powell of the District of Greenville for the sum of Sixteen Dollars & seventy five Cents being the highest sum that was bidden therefor: Now know ye, That I, David Hoke, Sheriff aforesaid, by virtue of the said Writ of fieri facias aforesaid, to me directed and delivered as aforesaid, and by virtue of the Statute in such case made and provided, and for and in consideration of the said sum of Sixteen Dollars and seventy five cents to me in hand paid, or secured to be paid by the said Stephen Powell the receipt and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said Stephen Powell his heirs and assigns forever, the said tract, piece and parcel of land, with its appurtenances, and all the estate, right, title and interest, which the said Moses Brown of right had, of, in, and to the same: To have and to hold the said piece, parcel and tract of land, with its appurtenances, unto the said Stephen Powell his heirs and assigns forever, as fully and absolutely as I the said David Hoke Sheriff, might, could, or ought to grant, bargain and sell the same by virtue of the Statute aforesaid, and the said Writ of fieri facias or otherwise.
