Beginning at a Stake in State Road and runs N. 31 E. 19.19 to a Stone 3 x. Thence N. 66 1/2 W. 24.20 to a Stone 3 x. Thence S. 37 1/2 W. 45 to a Stone 3 x. Thence S. 29 1/2 E. 9.70 ch. to a Stone 3 x. By a Small Pine 3 x. Thence N. 66 1/2 E. 40.95 ch. to a Stake 3 x in the State Road Thence down said Road S. 36 1/2 E. 12.23 ch. to the beginning Containing Eighty Four Acres be the same more or less and bounded by Lands belonging to William Cunningham Land granted to Jacob White, Lands belonging William Stone and my self and hath such marks and form as a plat. of the same will more fully represent.
