

forsaid in consideration of the sum of Nine Hundred Dollars to me paid by Joseph McCallough of the same State & Dist aforesaid have Granted Bargained, sold & released and by these presents do Grant. Bargain, Sell & release, unto the said Joseph McCallough all that Tract of Land containing Two Hundred and twenty five acres be the same more or less situate and lying in the State and Dist aforesaid, on the waters of Horse Creek known as the place where Mrs. Stone formerly lived surrounded on all sides by Lands of the said Joseph McCallough together with all and singular the rights members, Hereditaments and appurtenances, to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Joseph McCallough his heirs & assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs, Executors, and Administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Joseph McCallough his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other person or persons whomsoever, Lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this thirteenth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight Hundred and forty seven (1847) and the seventy second year of the Independence United States of America.
