And I do hereby bind myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend, all and singular the said Premises, unto the said William Cox his Heirs and Assigns, against myself and my Heirs, and against every person whosoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.



Premises within mentioned and released.


