the aforesaid State, in consideration of the sum of Seven Hundred Dollars to me paid by James M. Makin of Spartanburgh District in the State aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said James M. Makin A certain Tract or parcel of Land Lying in State & district aforesaid on the Creek waters of South Pacolet River Beginning at a Black oak on the South side of Creek and Running N 14° W 84 chains to a Pine, Thence S 73° E 23 chains crossing a branch to a Post oak Thence N 38° E. 8 chains to a Black oak on the Road, Thence S. 6° E 75 chains to a Black Oak, Thence S 61° E 15 chains to the beginning corner Containing one Hundred and Fifty Acres more or less Together with all and singular the rights, members, Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining, to have and to hold, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said James M. Makin his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular the said premises, unto the said James M. Makin his heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
