John W. Stokes of the District and State aforesaid and also for the  
further consideration of one Dollar to me in hand paid by the said  
John W. Stokes (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have given,  
granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do  
give, grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John W.  
Stokes all that tract and parcel of Land situate and lying  
in the District and State aforesaid on both sides of the Long  
Branch waters of Laurel Creek containing Three Hundred and  
thirty three acres - more or less; beginning at a Post oak x 3 III ont. and  
running thence S 5 E. 91 chs to a Pine x 3 III ont thence S 50 W. 17 to a  
Post Oak Stump x 3 III ont, thence N 60 W. 20.50 to a Stake x 3 III ont -  
thence S 30 W. 30.50 chs to a Stake x 3 III ont - thence N 60 W. 5 chs to a  
Stake x 3 III ont - thence N 60 W. 11 chs to a Pine x 3 III ont - thence N  
10 E. 40 chs to a Pine x 3 III ont - thence N 25 E. 9 chs to a Pine x  
3 III ont - thence N 34 E. 67 chs to the beginning, together with all  
and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurte-  
nances to the same belonging or in any wise incident or ap-  
pertaining: To have and to hold all and singular the prem-  
ises above mentioned unto the said John W. Stokes - his heirs  
and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs  
executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend  
all and singular the said premises unto the said John W.  
Stokes his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs  
and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or  
to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand  
and Seal this the 22<sup>nd</sup> day November in the year of our  
Lord one thousand Eight Hundred and forty seven and in  
the twenty second year of the independence of the United  
States of America.
