


The said Susan Waddill do hereby give Bargain sell
 and convey to the said James McCarter and Tolbert
 E. Waddill the negro woman Polly and her child
 Violet and their future increase to have and to hold
 the said negro woman Polly and child aforesaid and
 future increase in Trust that the same shall be and re-
 main in the possession of the said Susan for the joint
 use and benefit of herself and her intended Husband
 the said Peter Shockley for and during the life of the
 said Susan free from all liability for the debts and
 contracts of the said Peter Shockley after the solemn-
 ization of the said intended marriage the legal title
 of the said property being hereby vested in the said
 trustees, and they or their successors shall immediately
 after the death of the said Susan divide by sale
 or otherwise as may be agreed on the negroes aforesaid
 and their increase equally between my two children
 (viz) Tolbert E. Waddill and Martha Ann McCarter
 and all the children of the said Peter Shockley share
 and share alike, provided that if either of my two
 children or either of the children of the said Peter
 Shockley should at the time of distribution be dead
 or die before me then the heirs of such deceased child
 shall be entitled to the share which he or she would
 be entitled to if living.
