And the said party of the first part for himself and his heirs, the above described and hereby granted and released premises, and every part and parcel thereof, with the hereditaments and appurtenances, unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, against the said party of the first part, and his heirs, and against all and every person and persons whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same, shall and will warrant, and by these Presents, forever defend.
