State aforesaid. Since Greeting, Whereas by Virtue of sundry Writs of Fieri Facias,  
issued out of the Court of Common Pleas, held for the District of Greenville listed  
the Thirtieth day of January in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and Forty  
at the Seat of Peter Knobbe and others, to me directed commanding me, that

to me in hand paid or secured to be paid by the said Edmon Waddill the receipt and  
payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted, bargained and sold, and by these  
presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said Edmon Waddill his heirs and  
assigns forever, the said tract, piece and parcel of land, with its appurtenances, and all  
the Estate, rights, title and interest which the said David Hooke of right had, of  
in, and to the same: To have and to hold the said piece, parcel and tract  
land with its appurtenances unto the said Edmon Waddill his heirs and  
assigns forever, as fully and absolutely as I the said David Hooke, Esq. might, could  
or ought to grant, bargain and sell the same by virtue of the Statute aforesaid and  
the said Writ of Fieri Facias or otherwise
