paid by Alsey Neaves of the district of Greenville and State of South Carolina, the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained sold and released and
by their presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Alsey Neaves
all that Tract or parcel of Land situated in the district of Greenville & State
of South Carolina on waters of Muske Creek a branch of South Toga River it being a part
of a Tract of Land originally granted to John Nicksell, it being one part of
the real Estate of William Neaves Decd. Lot No. 3, beginning on a Sassafras Ox
Chain No. 80 W. 34. to a Stake, thence N. 20. E. 25. to Muske Creek, thence down
said creek to Mary Taylor's corner, distance known 3 X thence N. 31. E. 9. 75 to
Stake 3 X thence S. 56. E. 120 to Stake 3 X thence S. 68. E. 65. to Stake, 3 X thence
S. 47. W. 6. to Stake 3 X to Muske Creek at the mouth of a small creek thence S. 27
West 16 to Stake 3 X thence East side of the swamp to the beginning corner containing
Seventy four Acres more or less, together with all and singular the rights liberties
privileges, appurtenances to said premises in any wise incident or appertaining to
have and hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Alsey
Neaves his heirs and assigns forever and we do hereby ourselves our heirs, Executors
and Administrators and joint and several the premises of and unto
the said Alsey Neaves his heirs and assigns Administrators against ourselves our heirs
Executors, Administrators or assigns and against any other person or persons lawfully
