 the District and State before mentioned have granted, bargained, sold, released and
 by these presents do Grant bargain, sell and release unto the said Jesse Dean, all
 that parcel or Tract of Land containing One Hundred and Twenty eight acres or
 more and platted by John Young on the 1st Oct. 1806 lying and being in the
 District and State aforesaid, on Bushy Creek Waters ofuddy River, beginning
 at a black gum on Bushy Creek, running thence S 40 W 44.58 to a red Oak
