the purchase money and be accounted before the Commissioner for the distribution of  
the same

have granted, bargained, sold, released, convey'd, and by these presents, do grant  
bargain, sell release and convey unto the said William Choice all that lot a piece  
of land lying in the District of Greenville aforesaid, beginning at a Stake on the Pendleton  
Road near the fork leading to Anderson and running S 18° E 25° 38 poles or  
Tandy Walker line to a small black gum tree N 68° E 6° 32 poles to a Stake  
thence N 15° W 35° 38 poles to a Stake on the Pendleton Road and thence E 68° N 6° 32  
poles along the Pendleton Road to beginning corner as will more fully appear by reference  
to the Plat book aforesaid, containing One acre to the same more or less.

Together with all and singular the Rights, Members

Herdiments and appurtenances to the same, belonging or in use incident or  
pertaining to same and to hold all and singular the premises above mentioned and  
said William Choice and his heirs forever. And I do hereby bind myself and my heirs  
and successors to defend the premises aforesaid unto the said William Choice and his  
heirs myself and my heirs and the heirs of the late Dr. Richard Garrison
