hand paid by Thomas M. Cox of the State and District above stated. Know bargained sold and released and by these presents do bargain, sell and release, to the said Thomas M. Cox a certain tract or parcel of land, containing Ninety One Acres more or less, situated in the District of Greenville and State aforesaid. Lying on the North Side of Enoree River (The land to be conveyed), beginning at a small gum 3X on said River N 45° E 10' to a Willow 3X on Battinco Creek, thence up said Creek to a rock 3X thence N 48° W 6' to a small rock 3X thence S 49° W 46' 50" to a Stake 3X on the South side of said Creek thence said line to be the line to the said small gum 3X. Together with all and singular the rights, members, dividends and appurtenances to the said premises, belonging or in anywise incident, to have and to hold all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said person and his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever and for the purposes of said Thomas M. Cox his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns. You and I do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to defend and forever defend the above premises unto the said Thomas M. Cox his heirs, & against myself my heirs, & to every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
