South Carolina I know all men by Greenville District These presents that Joseph W Goodwin of the District and State aforesaid for and in consideration

of the sum of One Thousand Dollars to me in hand paid by William C Goodwin have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said William C Goodwin his heirs and assigns forever all my interest in a certain tract or parcel of Land which is one half situated in said District on the North Side of Saluda River containing Two hundred and fifty two acres more or less It being a part of a Tract of land conveyed by Joseph Goodwin Sr to myself and William C Goodwin and situate as the said place The part a tract now to be conveyed has such bounds marked as follows Viz Beginning at a white stake 3x near the said river, thence S. 44 E 44.50 chs to a light wood bush 3x on the original line of a grant made to John Ford, thence on same original line N 8 W 44 chs to a stake 3x on a branch, thence S 85 W 22.50 chs to a sycamore 3x on the South bank of said North fork of Saluda River thence up the meander of said River to the mouth of a creek called Crampfield about 34 chs, thence up the meander of said creek about 30 chs to a chestnut 3x thence S. 9 E 7 chs to a red oak 3x thence S. 44 W 24.20 chs to a red oak 3x thence S 25 W 8.20 chs to a fresh oak 3x thence S 69 E 37.50 chs to a water oak 3x on the North bank of said river, thence up the meander of said river in a direct line bearing about S 77 E to the beginning corner

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises, belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said William C Goodwin his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said
