Whereas Isaac S Henning and Mary Henning his wife James M. Mary Smith
were married on the 30 day of November A. D. 1844 And Wholly by virtue
and in right of said marriage, the said Isaac S Henning has become entitled
and possessed of a certain negro by name Edmund about the age of sixteen
years and whereas the said Isaac S Henning is minded and is disposed to transfer
and sell the said slave Edmund to and for the special use and benefit of
his wife. Now therefore know all men by these presents that I the said Isaac
S Henning for and in consideration of the natural love and affection I have
and bear towards my wife the said Mary Henning and in consideration
of the premises aforesaid and also in further consideration of the sum of one dollar
to me in hand paid by the said Philip W Powers the receipt of which is hereby
acknowledged I have bargained sold and delivered and by these presents do bargain
sell and deliver unto the said Philip W Powers the said slave Edmund To have
and to hold the said slave Edmund unto the said Philip W Powers his Executors and
Administrators upon the conditions and trusts and for the uses and purposes following
and none other namely that the said Philip W Powers shall hold the said slave
for and to the sole and exclusive use of the said Mary Henning and suffer her
to receive and enjoy the services hire and profits of the said slave to her separate use
free from any claims of the said Philip W Powers, or from any claims, contracts or debts
of the said Isaac S Henning. And if it shall ever be deemed expedient by the
said parties that the said slave should be sold, the said Philip W Powers upon the written
consent of the said Isaac S Henning, Mary Henning and himself shall sell and
convey said slave and receive the proceeds of the said sale to be held by him sub-
ject to the same trusts and conditions as are herein declared in relation to said
