 Hundred to me in hand paid by Bayles Potts of the District and State aforesaid have
 Given, Granted, Bargained, sold and released all my right title and Interest to
 my distribute share of a certain piece parcel, a tract of Land known as the Reach
 place lying and being situated in the District and State aforesaid on the North
 side of Ruddy River on Maple Creek waters of said River adjoining Lands of John
 Faulk, Lewis Rodgers, Anderson Pray, Barnett Smith, and others, the above tract
 of Land was willed to my mother and her heirs by John J. Pulte of Charleston
 and as I have now arrived at lawful age I do give grant, sell and release
 all my right title and Interest as an heir and legatee of my mother Patsy Potts
 to whom said tract of land was willed as above stated to the said Bayles Potts
 his heirs Executors, administrators and assigns To Have and to hold the above de-
 scribed Interest which I am now entitled to as above stated Together with all
 and singular the rights, members Hereditaments and appurtenances to the above
 described premises and I do warrant and forever defend the same from my
 heirs Executors, administrators and assigns to the said Bayles Potts and his
 warrant and defend the same from any person claiming or to claim the same a any
 part thereof.
