for and in consideration of the sum of Fourteen

Hundred dollars to me paid by Joseph M. Goodwin of the same State and that  
such sum granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain,  
sell and release unto the said Joseph M. Goodwin a certain tract of Land situated in  
said District on the North fork of Saluda river containing one hundred and fifty  
three acres, more or less it being part of a tract of land formerly belonging to Henry  
Blyth. Occasioned and purchased by me of Alfred Hightower the part now to be conveyed  
has such marks bounds &c as follows Beginning at a Stake 3x on each side of  
said river Thence N 83 E 38 chains to a Post oak 3x Thence S 86 12.50 chs to a  
pine stump 3x Thence S 89 E 6 chs to a Spanish oak 3x Thence S 13 E 6 chs to a Sas-  
safiss 3x Thence S 20 W 14.50 chs to a white oak 3x Thence S 9 W 5.25 chs to a  
cherry 3x Thence S 65 W 10.75 chains to a Spanish Oak 3x Thence N 63 W 7 chs to a  
Black Jack 3x Thence S 79 W 16 chs to a small red oak 3x Thence S 40 1/2 W 14.50  
chs to a Stake 3x on said river. Thence up the meanders of said river to the beginning corner  
a more full description may be had on a reference to a plat annexed to the former deed

premises unto the said Joseph M. Goodwin his heirs and assigns against myself my Heirs and  
against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
