release unto the said Tinsly Ballinger a tract of Land situated in Greenville
District on both sides of a small branch of South Tyger river Beginning at
a Stone and running S 72 $\frac{1}{4}$ W 36.00 to a small red oak Thence 35° 20' 32.80 to a
stone Thence S 81 $\frac{1}{4}$ E 33.84 to a stone, Thence N 19 W 16.53 to a Black Gum on a
branch Thence down the meanders of said branch to a white oak dead and down, Thence
N 14 E 38.50 to the beginning which contains the land to be conveyed, containing one
hundred and thirty five acres more or less. Together with all and singular the right
members hereditaments appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise incident or
appertaining I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant
and forever defend the rights and titles of the above described premises unto the said
Tinsly Ballinger his heirs executors Administrators and against every other person
whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof in witness I have caused to
set my hand and seal this 18th day of September in the year of Our Lord One
Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty eight and in the Twenty Second year of American
Independence
