bargained sold and released unto my said son Samuel a certain tract or parcel of
land situated in Guerrille District in the north side of South Packholle River being
a part of a Tract of land granted to Richard Ward bearing date fourth day of July
A.D. 1808 Beginning at a Hickory corner Thence N 45.00 ch to a branch cut
at the west end of the said rock of the Hogback Mountain Thence down the
various meanders of said branch to a certain tract of Land formerly granted to
Charles Gosnell Thence with said line to South Packholle River Thence up said river
to the upper line Thence N 27.40 to the beginning containing Ninety two or more
or less. Together with all and singular the rights incidents and appurtenances
to the said premises aforesaid unto the said Samuel Gosnell his heirs and assigns forever
To Have and to hold and I do hereby bind myself my heirs and assigns
Executors and administrators to warrant and defend all and singular
the premises aforesaid to the said Samuel Gosnell his heirs and assigns against
