I Absalom B Talley in the State and District aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred and Fifty Dollars secured to be paid by John S. Cox of Greenville district have granted bargain sold and release and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said John S Cox a certain parcel or tract of land situated in the District of Greenville and State aforesaid on the waters of the North Fork of Saluda being a part of a Tract of Land I purchased of my father this State commencing at a Poplar corner thence running S 56 W 10 chains and 50 links to Stake thence North N 17 W 32.50 to a Chestnut thence N 74 E 16.75 to a branch thence up the branch to the head 36.50 thence N 53 E 7.50 to P. O. at the head of a branch thence down the branch 38 to a Beech thence down same branch 250 to Chestnut thence S 21 W 18 chains to the beginning Poplar containing One Hundred and Twenty Five Acres by the same more or less

Together with all and singular the rights members, Accretions and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident appertaining To Have and to hold and singular the premises before mentioned to John S Cox his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself this Executor and administrator to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said John S Cox his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming the or to claim the same the same or any part thereof
