Hundred and Forty Nine and in the County of Greenville of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America Between Leander W. Casey of the District of Greenville in the State aforesaid by trade a Factor of the first rank and Susanah Hatcher of the District and State aforesaid of the second rank and Joseph Powell attorney at Law of the same place who as a marriage is intended by Gods permission shortly to be solemnized between the said Leander W. Casey and the said Susanah Hatcher And Whereas the said Susanah Hatcher is seized and possessed of certain real and personal property And whereas in prospect and in consideration of the said intended marriage it hath been agreed by and between the said parties to these presents that all and singular the said real and personal property wherof the said Susanah Hatcher is seized and possessed of shall be settled conveyed and disposed of to such uses upon such trusts and to and for such intents and purposes as are hereafter mentioned expressed and declared of and concerning the same Now this Indenture witnesseth that in pursuance of the said agreement in consideration of the said intended Marriage and for and in consideration of Five Shillings a price to them the said Leander W. Casey and Susanah Hatcher in hand well and truly paid by the said Joseph Powell at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is fully acknowledged by the said Susanah Hatcher by and with the concurrence and consent of the said Leander W. Casey her intended husband testified by him being a party to and signing and sealing these presents Both Grant Bargain sell assign transfer and deliver to the said Joseph Powell his Administrators and assigns all that tract or parcel of Land situated lying and being in the District and State aforesaid near the village of Greenville adjoining the lands of Dock Tidymann Wardy Mcbee and others containing Three Acres and a half also all my house held Furniture To wit Three Bedsteads Bed Sticks and furniture Five pine Tables Three wash stands Six Bowls and six Pitchers one mantle glass Two Gilt Mirrors ornaments Three Trunks One rocking chair Five common chairs Two dressing Glasses Three carpets Glass crockery and China ware One large waincot Two small waincot Shovel and tongs One pair of Two Dogs also all my cooking utensils To wit For oven and lids One Tin Kettle Two saucepans One wash Tub To clean and to hold the said real and personal unto the said Joseph Powell upon such trusts Remittances and to use for such uses intents and purposes as hereafter expressed and declared of and concerning the same that is to say In trust for the said Susanah Hatcher his Executors Administrators and assigns Until the solemnization of the said intended Marriage and from and immediately after the solemnization thereof That the Trust that the said Joseph Powell his Executors Administrators and assigns do and shall permit and suffer the said Leander W. Casey during the joint lives of himself and the said Susanah Hatcher his intended wife to have the occupation enjoyment direction and management of the Real and Personal property but so as the same shall not be liable in any manner or subject to his debts contracts engagements and to receive and to take the profits proceeds emoluments and advantages for this joint use and benefit and in case the said Susanah Hatcher should survive the said Leander W. Casey her intended husband Thus the Trust that the said Joseph Powell his
