Camp widow and Executrix of C H Camp deceased  
late of the District and State aforesaid in conformity

with the authority vested in me by the last Will and Testament of the said C H  
Camp deceased and for and in consideration of the sum of Nine Thousand and  
Dollars to me paid by William H Gilliland of Charleston in the State of South Carolina  
have Granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain  
sell and release unto the said William H Gilliland All that Tract of Land where  
I now live situated lying and being in the District and State aforesaid on the  
W<sup>th</sup> side of Tyger River having the following lines, batters and lines Beginning  
at the mouth of a Branch above the bridge, thence up a small ditch N 12°  
chains to a Stake on the bank of said ditch thence S 85° W 100.75 L to a Pusiminoe 34 thence  
N 12° W 9 ch to a Pusiminoe on the bank of the branch thence up the meander  
of the branch to a for across said branch thence N 48° W up an old road 60 ch  
78 L to a pine 34 thence N 42° E 48 ch 50 L to a Stake thence S 35° W 35 ch  
to a Post Oak 34 thence S 38 ch to a Pine corner thence S 27° E 13 ch 20 L  
to James May's line to a Birch corner thence to the river thence down the  
River to the Beginning, which Tract of Land was released to me as the Ex-  
ecutor of C H Camp deceased by Will from Mathias Huske bearing date  
1<sup>st</sup> day of October 1841 Containing One Hundred and Fifty Acres more or  
less

Together with all and singular the Rights Members, Hereditaments  
and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in any incident appertaining  
To have and to hold all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the  
said William H Gilliland and his Heirs and Assigns forever And I do  
hereby bind myself my Heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever  
defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said William H Gilliland  
his Heirs and Assigns against me and my Heirs and against every person  
whomsoever lawfully claiming as to claim the same or any part thereof.
