West in the full and just sum of Three Thousand dollars good and lawful of the State in which payment will and truly to be made We and each of us bind ourselves jointly and severally one joint and several heirs, executors, administrators and assigns finally by these presents Signed with our hands and sealed with our seals  
The 18th January 1849.

The Conditions of the above Obligation is such that if the above named obligors shall within a reasonable time make and execute unto the said William I. West a good and legal title in fee simple to twenty acres of Land part of the real estate of the said Isaac West deceased which under the Decree of the Court of Equity was conveyed by the Commission of the said Court to the Heirs of the said Isaac West deceased to be so laid off as to include Ten acres on the East side of Ready River and as much as the other and to include the shoal and water privilege when James West once had a Mill and to warrant and defend the Title against them and their heirs and all and every person claiming by, through or under them and no further than and in that cause the above obligation to be void and of no effect otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue in law and Equity.
