three hundred yards S. W. from my residence which ground I William Bates, do hereby
give and bequeath to my neighbors in said precinct for a school and for that only
relinquish all claim and Title from me my heirs and Executors forever Provided the same
is not converted to other purposes. It is shoud be thus the right returns to my heirs
I for this allow grant and assign to the said School House and its directors the
possession of the wood and what so long as the same is kept and converted
to the benefit of my neighbors in said precinct with the right of free passage
of Roads to and from said School House over my lands
