
State of South Carolina I know all men
Greenville District by these presents
that I William Bates, Senior, In behalf of

my neighbors and friends in my neighbor-

bout have thought fit to locate a School House on my Land as convenient to
my neighbors in said precinct. I. William Bates do hereby agree to give a full
acquittance, to one Acre of Ground, "A Square", around the School house Situated about
Three hundred yards S.W from my residence which ground I. William Bates, doth
give and bequeath to my neighbors in said precinct for my neighbors
relieving all claim and title from me my heirs and executors forever provided the same
is not converted to other purpose. If it should be thus the right returns to my heirs
I further allow, grant, and assign to the said School house and its directors the
priviledge of fire wood and water so long as the same is kept and converted
to the benefit of my neighbors in said precinct with the right of free passage
of Roads to and from said School house over my lands.

sell and release unto the said Joseph McCullotte all that plan to ten
or tract of Land Containing Two Hundred and Seventy nine Acres more or less
situated and lying in the State and District aforesaid on Bearwood Creek
waters of Saluda River bounded on the South and West by lands belonging
to Peter French on the North and East by lands belonging to the said Joseph

McCullotte Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments
and appurtenances to the same belonging or in anywise incident thereto pertaining

We have and do hold all and singular the said premises unto the said
McCullotte his heirs and assigns forever And do bind myself
executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and
