of her natural life and at her death in trust for the heirs of her body
To have and to hold the said Slaves Susan and Tom in trust for my daughter
Mary Caroline Hopkins for and during the term of her natural life
and at her death in trust for the heirs of her body and To have and to
hold the Slaves Harrick and Joe aforesaid in trust for my daughter Louisa
Hopkins for and during the term of her natural life and at her death in trust
for the heirs of her body and in the event that either of my said daughters shall
die without leaving heirs of her body then the slaves held in trust for such
